

**CITY OF LAKESHIRE  
PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING  
UNUSED PORTION OF 2015 & 2016 FUNDS FROM THE  
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM**

**FEBRUARY 13, 2017**

The public hearing was called to order at 6:30 p.m. In attendance were: Mayor Seher, Alderman Davis, Alderman Gebelein, Alderman Steel, Alderman Zumwalt, Alderman Bilzing, Chief Neidenberg, City Clerk Jill Feltmann, Jan McDermott, Ed Sallenbach and Marlene Phelan.

Mayor Seher stated that there are \$15,000.00 in unused funds from 2015 and \$20,000.00 unused funds from 2016 CDBG Funds that can be reallocated from housing to sidewalk and curbing repair and used for the handicap curb cuts along Tesson Ferry and in the city park. There is currently \$20,000.00 already in the City of Lakeshire's account, making the available total for the project \$55,000.00. The purpose of this meeting is to vote to use those unused funds from 2015 and 2016 for this project.

This plan will not touch any of the unused funds from 2017. Part of these funds must also be used for the architect's plans and specs for this project.
