City Clerk's Report as posted on the bulletin board: A motion was made by Alderman Bilzing to approve the minutes of the July 13, 2020 Board meeting as written. The motion was seconded by Alderman Pacheco. The motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Funk stated that there is a 4.8 month reserve in the general fund. Sales taxes and gas taxes are falling due to COVID-19. \$173 million has been distributed to St. Louis County from the CARES Act and waiting for distribution to the municipalities, hopefully by population. A motion was made by Alderman Bilzing to accept the Treasurer's report for the month of July2020 as written and checks #31857 through #31920 from the General Account plus three EFTPS payroll payments and four capital improvement check #487 through #490. The motion was seconded by Alderman Zumwalt. The motion carried.

Building Commissioner's Report: A motion was made by Alderman Zumwalt to accept the Building Commissioner's report for the month of July2020 as written. The motion was seconded by Alderman Pacheco. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Alderman Bilzing to approve a permit for Sam Randolph at 10043 Willdan Drive, Units A, B and C for the replacement of a two-ton AC and a 70,000 BTU furnace in each unit. The motion was seconded by Alderman Rhodes. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Alderman Zumwalt to approve a permit for Pat Sorrentino at 10132 Stonell

Drive for the replacement of a four-ton AC and a 100,000 BTU furnace. The motion was seconded by Alderman Pacheco. The motion carried.

City Attorney's Report: Attorney Henry briefly discussed the Purdue bankruptcy. Helmut Starr was checking to see if the City of Lakeshire was named in that case. She will see if he filed a claim on behalf of the city. A motion was made by Alderman Bilzing to accept and pay the city attorney's invoices for the month of July2020. The motion was seconded by Alderman Pacheco. The motion carried.

Prosecuting Attorney's Report: A motion was made by Alderman Bilzing to accept and pay the prosecuting attorney's invoice for the month of July2020. The motion was seconded by Alderman Zumwalt. The motion carried.

A. Ordinance to amend the 2020 Budget for the lower level remodel to improve insulation and wiring making the lower level a warmer and safer environment.

B. Discussion and ordinance for emergency street grate repairs. There was no bid process due to the fact that these are an emergency repair. The bid was for \$7,830.00 to just stabilize the concrete and reset the grates. This would give another five or six years until they would need to be repaired again. However, for an additional \$6,500.00 (or a total of \$14,330.00) the grates would be properly repaired giving another fifty plus years of use. A motion was made by Alderman Bilzing to accept the bid from Welker Welding, LLC in the amount of \$14,330.00 to fully repair the grates. It will take about two weeks to replace all three grates. The motion was seconded by Alderman Zumwalt. The motion carried.
