Discussion of Supplemental Police services for City of Bella Villa

The City of Bella Villa has contacted the City of Lakeshire to help them out with supplementing patrols a few days a week while they are trying to rebuild the numbers of their police force. There would be two drive throughs per day checking on the city. They would not be writing any tickets for the City of Bella Villa. There would be one drive by during the early afternoon shift and one on the midnight shift. This would take the officer out of the City of Lakeshire for about thirty minutes for each shift. The City of Bella Villa would pay the City of Lakeshire \$300.00 per twelve-hour period. The City of Lakeshire calls will supersede any calls for the City of Bella Villa.

As far as insurance goes, our cars would still be insured while in their city. Standard law enforcement policy will apply while in the City of Bella Villa. Our insurance company is still checking on the workers compensation side.

While the Lakeshire officer is in Bella Villa, they will let Chief Sullivan know of any problem. He will, in turn, contact the chief of Bella Villa to handle. The Bella Villa Chief has no authority over the Lakeshire officers. St. Louis County will respond if the Lakeshire officer can't.

This proposed contract would be good until the end of January, 2021. At that time, it could be revised.
