Discussion of 2022 Tax Rate: Mayor Seher read the information regarding the 2022 tax rate for the City of Lakeshire which has been posted.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAKESHIRE, MISSOURI LEVYING AND ESTABLISHING THE TAX RATE IN THE CITY OF LAKESHIRE, MISSOURI, FOR THE YEAR 2022 ON ALL PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION IN SAID CITY FOR GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES PER ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) OF ASSESSED VALUATION AT A RATE OF \$0.3040 ON ALL RESIDENTIAL REAL ESTATE AND \$0.3430 ON ALL COMMERCIAL REAL ESTATE.

Bill No. 21 was sponsored by Alderman Zumwalt and read by title only. A motion was made by Alderman Poschel and seconded by Alderman Aveytia to approve Bill No.21. Roll was called and the members of the Board voted as follows:



Having received six affirmative votes, Ordinance No. 1121 was approved.


