AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAKESHIRE, MISSOURI LEVYING AND ESTABLISHING THE TAX RATE IN THE CITY OF LAKESHIRE, MISSOURI, FOR THE YEAR 2024 ON ALL PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION IN SAID CITY FOR GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES PER ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) OF ASSESSED VALUATION AT A RATE OF \$0.3210 ON ALL RESIDENTIAL REAL ESTATE AND \$0.3460 ON ALL COMMERCIAL REAL ESTATE.
