After completing the review of the sewers, they will provide options for repair or replacement of the sewer grates that won't interfere with MSD's system. Attorney Bramman expects a presentation to the Board of Aldermen at the March 2026 meeting or April 2026 meeting at the latest.

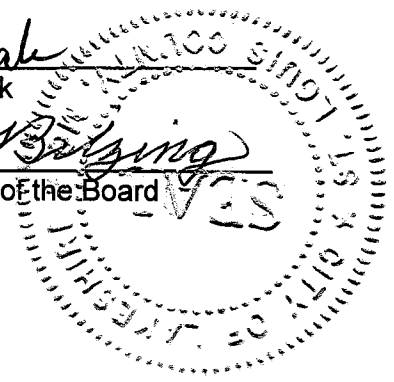
Adjournment: A motion was made to adjourn by Alderman Bilzing at 7:30 p.m. The motion was seconded by Alderman Poschel. The motion carried.

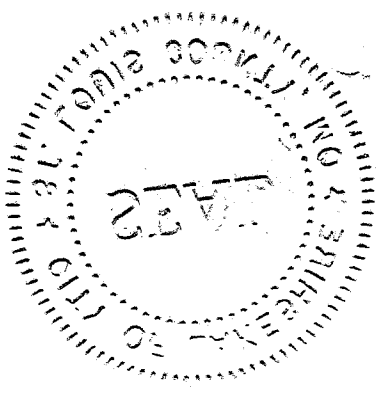
